ORDER

The Court conducted a remote hearing on Plaintiff's Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings. Plaintiff appears by counsel, David Roland; Defendant appears by counsel, Lopa Blumenthal. Defendant made an oral request for leave to file an answer out of time. In light of the Defendant's reckless, dilatory, and intentional refusal to timely file a responsive pleading, even after the Court previously granted Defendant an additional thirty days within which to do so, that request is denied.
